## OPERATIONS

December was a huge month for the Club and without delving into our financial history, we believe our turnover for the month set a new monthly record by a comfortable margin. Our year to date net profit for the nine months to end December is 400% and turnover 24% ahead of the comparative period last year. This is very pleasing to report and the net profit could have been even better if we had not taken to account some considerable repairs and maintenance, development and promotional costs. Some of the costs are attributable to our enhancing of the Club as a function venue, so could be rightfully deemed an investment for the future. Much of the repairs and maintenance costs are however attributable to the age of our building, plant and equipment. It is comforting that we are now trading sufficiently well, to not only pay our creditors on time and cover all our operating costs but also able to meet repairs and maintenance costs as they occur.

Our ability to host more functions has, as we thought, been boosted greatly by having the Weka Room ( previously Bridge Room ) available. Between mid October and end December, we have hosted 16 functions in this room. Having the room available has enabled us to more vigorously market the Club as a function venue. This room is proving popular as it is seen as separate to the rest of the Club.



We need to consolidate on the tremendous gains made this financial year. The 2020/21 Budget will be driven by us doing just that and continuing to provide for further upgrading whilst meeting all essential operating costs and delivering a satisfactory net profit.

### SALE OF OLD COURTESY VAN

Your Committee has approved the sale of our old Courtesy Van, to our Operations Manager, on as “ as is where is “ basis, at market value. Andre has agreed to make the vehicle available as a Club runabout whilst at the Club, for odd tasks where we prefer not to use our new Van. Whilst it stays “ alive “ it can also be used as an additional courtesy van during busy periods.

# GREENDALE SERVICES

Greendale Services Association Inc.

Feedback we have received indicates that the general Taradale Club membership does not know who may join us; also what we actually do.

Who are we:

We are a group of both military veterans plus also community minded groups and members.

Traditionally there are a large number of 'forgotten' community groups and services that need to be recognized; we have ensured that our Constitution includes these Groups:

- Ø Returned and Services Membership: NZ Defence Force; plus Commonwealth of Nations; plus persons who has served with the Commonwealth of Nations at the time of their service
- Ø Merchant Navy of New Zealand and Commonwealth countries at time of their service
- Ø Police Force of New Zealand: past & serving members;
- Ø Police Force of other Commonwealth Nations
- Ø Fire & Emergency New Zealand
- Ø New Zealand Customs Service
- Ø St John Ambulance New Zealand
- Ø Corrections Department of New Zealand
- Ø Department of Conservation New Zealand
- Ø New Zealand Customs Service
- Ø New Zealand Cadet Forces
- Ø Patriot Members: For those that do not qualify for the above categories. They have the same rights and privileges of membership as apply to Returned and Services members, and include:
  - o The Spouse/partner of a current Returned and Services member or the surviving spouse/partner of a deceased Returned and Services member;
  - o Children or grandchildren of a Returned and Services member; or
  - o Persons not otherwise entitled as above may be admitted as a Patriot Member where they affirm a commitment to the Spirit of Anzac and are willing to assist the Association in its maintenance and advancement.

Please note, with one exception for persons residing over 25km from the Taradale Club, and do not use the facilities on a regular basis, ALL of our members MUST be a Financial Member of the Taradale Club; the former do not get issued Taradale Club membership whereas the remainder have to be full financial members and go through the same process. Membership: Greendale Services Association \$20 yearly, plus if you are not a Taradale Club member, \$40. Other Taradale Club membership categories such as family are available; please speak to the Taradale Club Office for details. Note that our income is derived purely from Donations, Grants, Bequests, and raffles.





# GREENDALE SERVICES

The Taradale Club membership application has to be approved by the Taradale Club Executive, plus also the Greendale Services Association Inc . Committee

What do we do? In addition to maintaining the Spirit of ANZAC, a major role is providing Welfare and Support not only to our members, but incorporates the Taradale Club members as well. Whilst we would prefer you to join the Greendale Services Association ,you do not have to do this in order to obtain assistance. This assistance can be: loan of mobility equipment for either a small fee - if financially you are able; assistance with bureaucracy in completing the numerous forms; helping you with direction to other agencies that can assist you; arranging heavily discounted firewood and carpet clearing. We do not receive any money from these and if you are able, a small donation would be gratefully received. These monies are used to fund assistance to all that we can...

Some of you may qualify for having the following services paid for by WINZ or Veteran Affairs;

Podiatry discounted services by a professional – either at your home or at the Taradale Club.  
Lawns, house windows, house washing, gardening:

Mobility issues? Greendale Services Association has three Mobility Scooters, 1 x walkers, 1 set of crutches & walking sticks available for your use plus some other mobility aids. If you have any sitting at home and not being used, please either donate or loan them to us so that they can be used by people in need.

Fuel Discount Scheme: We have investigated substantial discount on petrol and diesel at a providers that will save you money. The way it will be structured that in addition to your discount, the Greendale Services Association will receive a further 1 c a letter into the Greendale Services Trust Account that will be dedicated purely to welfare support of our members and the community. We are just awaiting the Trust to be established: watch this space...

I have tried to keep this brief but to let you know what the Greendale Services Association is about, this is not possible. If you wish, we can come and address your interest group to fully explain all that we offer.

Greendale Services Association THE GREENDALE SERVICES ASSOCIATION TRUST FUND is in the process of being established. This is completely separate to the Greendale Services Association. Through this entity, assistance can be requested. Once established, the Trust Deed will be available for all who wish to view it.

Thank you..The Greendale Services Association wishes to thank the Taradale Club Management Committee and staff, plus the Taradale Club membership for their support in us coming to the Taradale Club. We are certainly building our membership and you will see as the months & years progress that we are 'people helping people' which of course means you, the Taradale Club members. If there is anything you need a hand with, simply ask and we will see if we can help.





# GREENDALE SERVICES UPDATE

One of the most important events we all share and participate in as a Nation each year is ANZAC Day. This commemoration is not about glorifying war. It is about reminding us of the dreadful cost, of the sacrifices made by too many, for our peace and freedoms. But importantly for us veterans it is also about educating the young people in 'Our Village' in the hope that they will not suffer as previous generations have

As part of this 'education', each year the Services Association hosts The Schools' 'Spirit of Anzac' Speech Competition. Again this year all schools in the wider Taradale District have again been invited to participate. The finals will be held at the Taradale Club on 27 March, timings to be confirmed. There are 4 grades - Years 5/6, Years 7/8, Years 9/10, and Years 11/12/13.

We invite and encourage members of the Taradale Club to attend this event and see the future leaders of our community in action. Without any doubt you will be amazed by how our young people research, develop, and then present their speeches. Be warned though - bring tissues as you will need them.

And isn't it great to see the War Memorial Building on the Marine Parade restored to its rightful name and place in our community. Members of the Association have been among those fighting for this wrong to be righted, and well done to Mayor Kirsten for ensuring this was fixed. Kirsten and Neil are of course also proud members of the Taradale Club and of our Association. But the work is not finished. We need to see a memorial in place that will provide for remembrance, education, and which honours those whose names it bears.

And next time you visit the Taradale Cemetery note the white crosses and the Totara trees planted next to them. This is NOT the work of the RSA This is a Services Association project with help from Tu Uru Rakau (Forestry) and the NCC. Each of the 47 trees represents one of the WWI fallen from our District, with one for the Unknown Warrior. Our members water and care for the trees almost daily and within 18 months will add trees for our fallen heroes from WW2 and other conflicts.

The Services Association is very much Club and community oriented and you don't have to be ex military to join. If you want to help build your community then we would welcome you as a member.

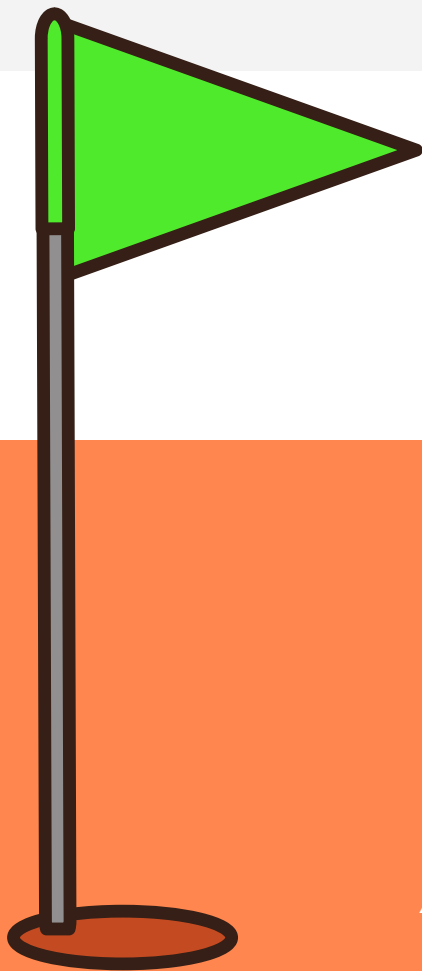
