

A WORD FROM OUR CHAIRMAN

OPERATIONS

I am pleased to report our great start to the current year has continued through the month of June. Our average weekly turnover since 1 April has been very pleasing and whilst we have set ourselves a stretch budget for the year, the first quarter has given us a solid start. We have incurred some significant costs during the period with some fairly major repairs and maintenance costs and our accounting costs have been considerably above budget. Our accounting costs were higher due to implementing the change from Myob to Xero over the latter months of our previous financial year and into the early part of our new financial year, changes in Office personnel and difficulties experienced in producing our annual accounts. We are now through these difficulties and have implemented some changes which will put us in better stead going forward.

We have enjoyed some great Adjunct activity since the start of our new year, with Outdoor Bowls, Indoor Bowls, Pool and Racing all hosting some major events. Visitors to our Club have been very impressed with the facilities we have, the services we provide, the small, hard working and friendly staff we have, with many complimentary comments made. As Club Members, we should all be proud as should our respective Adjuncts, for the work they put in securing, organising and hosting these events.

FINANCIAL

We recorded a very satisfactory net profit result for the month of April.

Accounts for the months of May and June are still to be finalised, however based on our very satisfactory weekly turnover figures, we expect these two months to be pleasing also.

We are now close to getting our 2020/21 Annual Accounts signed off by our Auditor. When we receive this we will post a copy of the audited accounts on our website and notify you all. Those requiring a paper copy will be able to pick one up from the Office by phoning in and requesting a copy.


ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

OUTDOOR BOWLS




