We deliberately focus on growing this understanding and knowledge in our young people as they are the future. As the saying goes 'It takes a village to grow a child' and we are all a part of that 'village'. And despite the negatives we often hear we are inspired and frankly 'blown away' by what our young people achieve and we see that our future is in very good hands.

Recently we have run both the Schools' Spirit of Anzac Commemoration and the Schools' Spirit of Anzac Speech Competition. This is the fourth year we have run both and again this year they were a huge success. The Commemoration, which was held on 12 Apr 2019, was again planned, organised and conducted by the young people from our community, mentored by veterans, for the young people of our community. More than 1,500 students from schools in the Taradale District attended, along with veterans, parents/grandparents, and members of the public. It was a really inspiring event.

Taradale High School student, Ekta Raturi, was the guest speaker at the Commemoration and captured the whole value and need for remembrance beautifully when she said, 'Peace and freedom come at a price. And we as a country have already paid that price'. What a wonderful acknowledgement and tribute to those who never returned. And what insight from a lovely young lady and future leader in our community. In these words Ekta is also imploring us to not repeat the mistakes of our past.

We applaud those sentiments. Well done Ekta!!!

Then on 6 May we held the finals of the Schools' Spirit of Anzac Speech Competition. Again, what an amazing day this was listening to our young people talking about a very emotional and difficult subject and expressing their heartfelt thoughts, ideas and views in such an eloquent fashion. If you get the chance to attend these speeches next year do so, and if you don't have to wipe the odd tear away you are a tougher person than us veterans.

All of those that make these finals are winners, they are all acknowledged and they all get a prize. 
