A WORD FROM THE CHAIRMAN

OPERATIONS

We have probably all heard the saying that “ strategy is about accepting the challenges along the way, choosing to keep moving forward and savouring the journey.”

We are both proud and pleased to report to our members our results for first half of our 2019/20 financial year to 30 September, clearly illustrate our strategy is delivering. For the six month period our turnover is 17% ahead of budget and 20% ahead of last year with net profit before depreciation 29% ahead of budget and 36% ahead of last year. Our journey has therefore begun in earnest and we are on target to achieve our full year targets. The marked turnaround in our Club fortunes means we can look forward to future years with a degree of confidence.

Your Committee and our Management team, so ably led by Andre, are fully committed to our strategy continuing to be successfully implemented and producing profitable results. In doing so we can repay debt, continue to upgrade our facilities, invest wisely in the future of our Club and reward all our stakeholders.

We again take this opportunity to thank our members who support our Club so well, all our Staff and other stakeholders for their respective contributions to this excellent result to date. Whilst we still have much to achieve we have confidence we can do so by pushing forward with our current strategy which will result in us all being winners and sharing in savouring the journey.

FUNCTION ROOMS

We have re-named our function rooms for ease of marketing and identification and have chosen to use names of native birds in keeping with the Pikopiko Restaurant name which is also nature inspired. The new names are:-

Fantail Room	Previously known as our large function room.
Weka Room	Previously known as the bridge room.
Kiwi Room	Previously known as our bowlers snug
Owl Room	Previously known as the Committee room

There is no doubt by having such a range of rooms to offer, with all the above four plus the Restaurant, is greatly enhancing our reputation as serious function venue. Having the Weka Room now available has been a real winner for us, with many of our new customers indicating a strong preference for a room of this size and away from the mainstream Club. We have secured many of our recent bookings, principally by having this room available.

RESTAURANT ON LICENSE

We are very pleased to report we have been granted an " On License " in respect of our Restaurant. It was unanimously agreed by our Committee at our July meeting to make application for this license. This effectively means we can open our Restaurant for the purpose of serving food and alcoholic beverages to other than Club members without applying for special licenses. As we already hold a Club license in the name of the Club, it was necessary for us to make application for the On License in an alternative name. We therefore decided to form a Company, named Piko Piko Trust which is 100% owned by the Club and apply for the license in this name.

Through being granted this License we expect to generate increased revenue whilst making real savings in the long term, in respect of licensing fees.

COURTESY VAN (R.I.P.)

Our courtesy van, which is close to 20 years old and has nearly 370,000 km on the clock is coming to the end of it's cost effective life. Our last mechanical report indicates we are likely to be up for repair costs, greater than the van is worth, in the not to distant future. Your Committee has, after considering all options, unanimously agreed to purchase a new LDV V80, 11 seater van and sell our old van, on an " as is, where is basis". The new van comes with a 3 year or 100,000 km warranty.

We will continue to provide our courtesy van service, free of charge to Club members but will be asking for a gold coin donation from non members of our Club. Should our members, who use this service wish to also make a contribution, that will be greatly appreciated. We will also have raffle nights throughout the year, solely to assist with funding the purchase and running costs, so will appreciate members support by purchasing raffle tickets on these nights.

Our vastly improved financial position, means we are in a position to make such a decision, which is very pleasing to your Committee and hopefully, to all our Members.

Members Subscriptions were due and payable by 30 September last. We remind all those who have not paid their subscription by 31 October, you are not able to accumulate loyalty points or be eligible to participate in our Members Draw until paid.

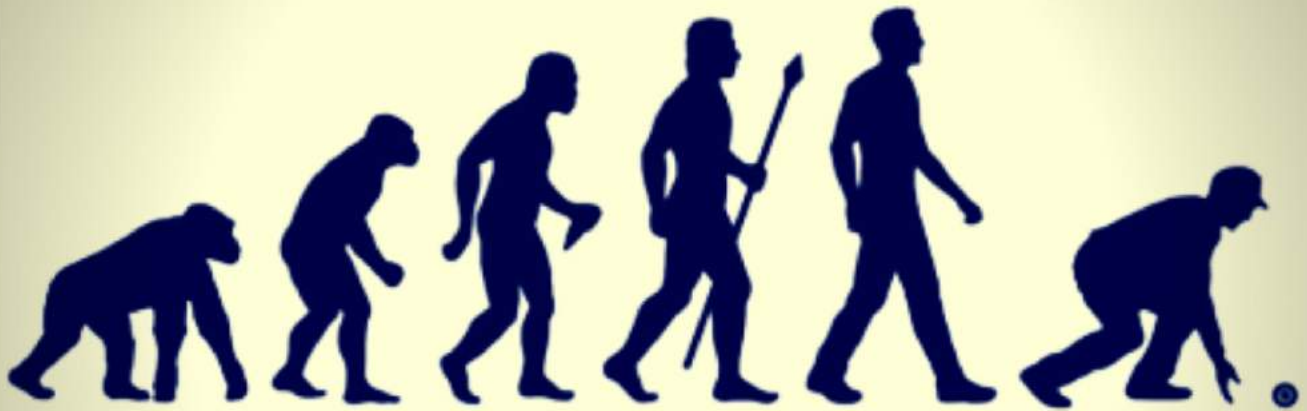
